Heart Failure Self-Assessment Module (SAM)

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of Part A, the physician will be able to demonstrate knowledge in:

1. Understanding and identifying the pathophysiology of heart failure
2. Diagnosing and classifying heart failure
3. Managing acute and decompensated heart failure
4. Managing heart failure pharmacologically
5. Managing heart failure nonpharmacologically
6. Understanding complications of heart failure treatment
7. Understanding advanced heart failure treatment

Measures of success include:

1. 80% of questions correctly answered within each competency area
2. 80% successful completion rate for questions overall
3. Upon successful completion, progression to the simulation component (Part B)

Upon completion of Part B, the physician will be able to demonstrate skill in:

8. Taking a history for a heart failure case
9. Performing a physical examination for a heart failure case
10. Performing a laboratory evaluation for a heart failure case
11. Managing a heart failure case

Measures of success include:

Carrying out at least 50% of the performance actions/interventions, as specified by ACC/AHA guidelines, in taking a history, performing a physical examination, performing a laboratory evaluation, and managing a case, during the simulated clinical encounter.
