Application Form and Abstract due date: December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016

Announcement of finalists: February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017

Presentation due date for finalists: April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017

Conference dates: April 2017 – t.b.d.

### ELIGIBILITY - POSTER PRESENTATIONS SESSION:

- All Family Medicine residents and third and fourth year medical students in the state of Maine are invited to participate
- Works in Progress, Quality Improvement, Clinical Research, and Clinical Vignettes may be presented
- Abstracts must be sent in by the deadline below
- Resident abstracts will be considered for the poster competition and oral presentation session
- Participants must register for and attend the MAFP Family Medicine Update and be present to answer questions during designated display times (both Resident and Student registration fees are deeply discounted – registration available on line Jan. 30<sup>th</sup>)

### POSTER COMPETITION DETAILS:

- Upon receipt of all abstracts by due date below, the selection committee will choose three finalists who will present their project or case vignette at the Maine AFP Annual Update
- Finalists will be allocated 10 minutes for the presentation and 5 minutes for a question/answer portion
- Judges will select a winner among the three finalists who will be announced at the conference
- Final winner will be given an Amazon gift card worth \$100.00
- **Medical students** are also advised to submit abstracts by the due date below. However, these abstracts will not be judged and we will expect all abstracts to be presented at the Annual Update
- Participants may submit one abstract

## **ABSTRACT GUIDELINES:**

- 350 – 450 word count limit

## **MUST INCLUDE:**

Works in Progress, Quality Improvement, Clinical studies:

- Introduction and Objective
- Methods
- Results or anticipated results
- Discussion

Clinical Vignettes:

- Introduction
- Case Presentation
- Discussion

## **POSTER SIZE & MOUNTING GUIDELINES:**

- Printed Poster **no larger** than 8 ft x 4 ft
- Poster must be mounted on foam board to display on an easel
- Should include all sections highlighted above in abstract guidelines
- Poster should be in appropriate font and coloring in order to readable
